Discussion:

• Note the context of the Book of Leviticus – camped at Mt. Sinai for whole book.

- **Note** the context of the Book of Deuteronomy after 40 years, before crossing the Jordon to conquer the promised land.
- **Remember** the importance of Jewish promises and covenants in a study of end-time prophecies, due to the intermingling of prophecies.

- **Discuss** importance of understanding the people, culture, and laws under God to whom the prophecies were made.
- Discuss the divine relationship context of biblical prophecies, and also how they are based on laws and principals, not just random babbling from some mystical "Oracle of Delphi."
- Note that there is a continuity in Bible prophecy which moves consistently from the Patriarchs, Moses, the Kingdom Age prophets, Daniel, Restoration Age prophets, John the Baptist, and Jesus Christ (Gospels and Revelation).
