<b>Revelation 1:1-5 (1-8)</b>	Address
<b>Revelation 1:9-20</b>	Authority of this Book
<b>Revelation 2:1-3:22</b>	To the 7 churches (1, 8, 12, 18, 3:1, 7, 14)

**The Tribulation**

<b>Revelation 4-5</b>	Scene in heaven
<b>Daniel 9:27 (24-27)</b>	70 seven year periods, the last one
<b>Revelation 6-7</b>	Time of Jacobs Trouble – First 6 seals
<b>Revelation 8-11</b>	Great Tribulation – 7 <sup>th</sup> seal, 7 trumpets
<b>Revelation 12-13</b>	Satan, Michael, the beasts

**Acts of Jesus Christ**

<b>Revelation 14:1-19:21</b>	Return and Conquest of Christ
<b>Revelation 20:1-6, 7-10</b>	Millennial reign of Christ
<b>Revelation 20:11-15</b>	Great White Throne judgment
<b>Revelation 21:1-22:21</b>	The eternal state, new heaven and earth (!)

**Discussion:**

- **Discuss** the inspiration of the Book of Revelation, dictation style, like Moses.
- **Discuss** the glorious presentation of Christ
- **Note:** The seven churches were actual physical churches and are listed in such a way as a traveler would reach them, one after another along the road.
- **Note:** The enduring distinction between the Jews and Gentiles (“nations”)
- **Terms:** Rapture, “Time of Jacob’s Trouble”, “Great Tribulation”, “Day of the Lord”, Kingdom, “eternal state”
- **Note:** At the Great White Throne judgment, those without Christ are judged by their works – none of which are sufficient.
