Discussion:

- **Date/Setting Note:** Paul has only visited Crete for the first time, and Titus is supervising the new churches
- Note the relevance that I Timothy would have had for Titus and the similarity of purpose of the two books.
- Note the relevance of interaction among the different age groups (2:2-8)
- Note the instance of church discipline in 3:10.
