The Author:

Paul, previously Saul, a Pharisee (Sanhedrin?), feared persecutor, highly educated (Gamaliel) (Acts 22:1-3) Tarsus a major metropolis (farm + sea + political/military importance) with a reputation for education compared to Athens and Alexandria.

Timeline:

Written by Paul, Autumn of 49 AD.
16 Years after Pentecost
5-10 years after Book of James
After 1st Missionary Journey (Acts 14:23-28)
After Jerusalem Council vs. Judaizers (Acts 15:1-35)
Written from Antioch, just before 2nd Missionary Journey (Acts 15:36⁺)

The Church:

Jewish believers and "God-fearers" and proselytes.

Fist Missionary Journey

Cyprus and lower Galatia Emphatic acceptance and emphatic hostility Set up elders in every church (Acts 14:23)

Galatians Chapter One

Vs 1-5 Salutation

v 1 Apostleship commissioned by God, not man (Act 9:1-19, 13:2-3

v 2 Includes the church at Antioch (Barnabas)

v 3 Grace and peace

v 5 Evangelism

Vs 6-9 Another Gospel being preached!

Judaizers!

Vs 10-12 Defends Apostleship

Vs 13-24 More background, but we don't know exactly what he is refuting...
