Hurtful jabs – most effective against those we love – we know how to stab and twist the knife!

Gossip – malicious motivation, irreparable damage.

Cruel lies – causing harm, gaining advantage, ego-wars

Boasting – arrogance destroys compassion and peacemaking, prevents reasonable yielding.

Convincing others to sin – peer pressure for other to condone by participation, or in order to multiply damage against someone.
