Lesson Text:

Luke 16:1-8a, 8b	Parable of the Unrighteous Steward, Interpretation
Luke 16:9-12	Be faithful in worldly stewardships, in order to be given greater stewardships.
Luke 16:13-15	You can only serve one of two masters. Expanded parallel is Matthew 6:19-24 .
Luke 16:16-17	Confusion regarding dispensational changes, Messiah fever, and the reliability of Scripture.
Luke 16:18	Divorce for adultery's sake
Luke 16:19-31	The story of the Rich Man and Lazarus

Discussion:

- For vs. 1-8; Consider the practical aspects of respecting the secular wisdom of the world, as we live by the wisdom of God – note that the practice of reducing debt, if done in accordance with the steward's master, would not be sin or harmful.
- Compare vs. 9-14 with Colossians 3:22-24
- Discuss the implications of vs. 19-31, especially vs. 31.
