| Judges 4:11-13 | Sisera comes to attack |
| Judges 4:14-16 | The army's defeat |
| Judges 5:3-5 | Believed to indicate a Christophany – an OT incarnation of Christ. |
| Judges 5:4b, 21a | Routing of Sisera's army by torrential flooding |
| Judges 4:17-22 | Jael, Heber's wife, slays Sisera |
| Judges 4:23-24, 31b | Defeat of Jabin, King of Canaan – 40 years of peace. |
