Lesson Text:

Discussion:

- Note and Discuss the distinct article "the" in verse 1 before the word "faith", which is left out of most translations, but identifies saving faith vs. general degrees of faith.
- Note that the discussion of meats is in an 'understood' context of both to meats which were 'unclean' under the Laws of Moses, and probably also in regards to meat sold in the markets after being sacrificed to idols.
- Discuss denominational considerations between Christians
- **Discuss** distinctions in Christian liberties in comparison with individual liberties at school or at work.

Open Question:

How should relate with other churches of our own denomination or of other Christian denominations (Methodist, Pentecostal), or of heretical denominations (Catholic, Islam)?

How does this passage relate to Christian who drink or smoke, or who work on Sundays?
