#### Lesson Text:

Romans 4:23-25	Antecedent for the "therefore" starting verse 1 of chapter 5.
Romans 5:1-2	Thru Jesus Christ, we obtain peace with God thru faith by grace to
	result in eventual glorification.
Romans 5:3-5	God's love applied to tribulation
Romans 5:5-8, 9-11	Proof of God's love
Romans 5:12-19	Doctrine of Imputation
Romans 5:20-21	The role of the Law

#### **Discussion:**

- **Discuss** the dynamics of our relationship with God, as a result of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross as summed up in vs 1-2.
- Note that the Greek word translated "hope" means to "anticipate <u>with confidence</u>" as opposed to the English word "hope" which <u>does not include confidence</u>, as in, "I hope our team wins, but I don't think we can."
- Discuss the legal/judgment system of imputation
- **Discuss** that the Law causing "transgression to increase" highlighted the sins of man you can't break a law that doesn't exist. Breaking a law is more clearly a picture of violation than just "wrong living" without a written/legal point of reference. Consider Genesis 4:16-24.
