Handout: The Disciples and Apostles of Jesus Christ

Jesus begins in Galilean Synagogue

Luke 4:14-21 - Jesus identifies Himself – Isaiah 61:1-2a, STOPS.

Luke 4:22-30 - Rejection of Jesus in Nazareth > Shifts to Capernaum and Jerusalem

Jesus' early ministry

Luke 4:31-44 - Spoke with authority, cast out demons who declared his authority, healed the crowds miraculously

Jesus gathers His disciples

John 1:35-51 - Andrew and (James or **John**) leave John the Baptist to become disciples of Jesus

Andrew is Peter's brother, James and John are brothers, Phillip and Nathanael are acquaintances of Andrew and Peter

Luke 5:1-11 - Peter & Andrew, James & John (Matthew 4:18-22 Next day?)

Luke 5:27-28 - Call of Levi, came to call sinners, not righteous, to repentance

Luke 6:12-16 - "Official designation" of disciples
