Sermon on the Mount

Matthew 6:1 (1-18) Serve God, not our own reputation

Church leaders – don't do and say the things that continuously prove to the congregation that you're worthy of the office, just keep serving God **Everyone** – No man can serve two masters; not God and Mammon (financial greed), or likewise, not God and politics.

Matthew 6:2-4 Giving without fanfare

A matter of compassion: Deuteronomy 15:7ff A matter of service to God, or not? Colossians 3:23 A matter of faith (v. 4)

Matthew 6:5-6 Prayer without fanfare

The awesome privilege and responsibility becomes a show??? Infinite time could be dedicated to a study of the power and effectiveness, and personal need for prayer!

Matthew 6:7-8 Prayer with meaning, specific praying

Does this mean liturgical prayer is wrong – absolutely not if prayed from your heart, it is like training our heart towards God, and not the same as pagan chants. (vs. 9-13)

Personal advice: When praying during emotional turmoil, write your prayers. This aids focus/ gives clarity.
