Matthew 6:9a Our heavenly Father

Matthew 6:9b Hallowed be Thy Name

Matthew 6:11 Provide for THIS day (see Matthew 6:19-34, esp. v. 33)

Matthew 6:12 Forgive us, as we have forgiven others (see vs. 14-15)

Matthew 6:13a Do not lead us into temptation (situations which will be morally difficult) – No man is tempted by God (James 1:13-15), but there are times when Christians find themselves in circumstances where temptations abound. Personal example, I am absolutely sure that God directed my enlistment in the US Marines...

Matthew 6:13b Deliver us from evil (I Corinthians 10:13)

Prayer is a topic which can easily be the study-focus of a lifetime.

Prayer is nothing less than one-on-one communication with the Creator of the universe, and the Author of our salvation.

Commandments to pray, instructions on how to pray, requests for prayer, examples of prayer, results of prayer – all these are given over and over, and from Genesis to Revelation.

An active prayer-life is one of the core responsibilities of Christians.

Why We Pray

Pray without ceasing. (1 Thessalonians 5:17 AV)

Reasons for prayer for self & others and in thanksgiving & praise. Importance of a quiet time and prayer in unison. Prayer keeps our heart open to God.

 - B: Praise Psalm 150
- IV. Benefits of communion with God
 - A: Requires us to be holy and submissive.
 - B: Brings us God's perspective on our life. } Isaiah 55:8-9
 - C: Better understanding of the heart & mind of God. }
 - D: Makes God an active part of our life.
