
INTRODUCTION

1. From the Nile to the Euphrates



David Conquered, David & Solomon Reigned


1. From the Nile to the Euphrates

2. "...And (Solomon) was ruler over all the kings from the Euphrates River even to the land of the Philistines, and as far as the border of Egypt."





God - spoken to Moses

Promised to Moses & Joshua Conquered under Joshua








Land conquered under Moses

Conquest in Numbers 31 Granted in Numbers 32

- Gad, Reuben, half of Manasseh
- Obligated to fight for the rest of the land with the rest of Israel
- Confirmed in Joshua 13:8






Jericho, Ai, Gibeon

Jericho – Joshua 6 Ai – Joshua 7-8 Gibeon – Joshua 9

- Famous defeat of Jericho
- Sin of Achan, defeat at Ai
- Ai conquered
- Deceit of Gibeon





5 Kings Attack Gibeon Joshua 10:1-5


- God killed more with hailstones then Israelites using swords Joshua 10:11
- 2. The day the sun stood still Joshua 10:12-15





Southern Campaign Joshua 10:29-43

V. 42 Joshua captured all these kings and their lands at one time, because the LORD, the God of Israel, fought for Israel.





Northern Campaign Joshua 11:1-23

V. 23 So Joshua took the whole land, according to all that the Lord had spoken to Moses... Thus the land had rest from war.



Joshua the Giant-Slayer

Numbers 13:22, 32-33

... Hebron, where ... the descendants of Anak were.

... all the people whom we saw in it are men of great size. There also we say the Nephilim (the sons of Anak are part of the Nephilim)...

Joshua 11:21-22

Joshua... cut off the Anakim ... from Hebron, from Debir...Joshua utterly destroyed them with their cities.

...no Anakim left ... only in Gaza, in Gath, and in Ashdod some remained.

1 Samuel 17:4

...Goliath, from Gath, whose height was (~9' 4").





Division of the Land by Tribe Joshua 13-19

Why is there 12 Territories?

- 1. Twelve original tribes (12)
- 2. The tribe of Levi received no territory, as they were to serve throughout the land (11)
- There is no tribe of Joseph He received a double blessing from Israel and an inheritance for each of his two sons – Ephraim and Manasseh. (12 again)
