"First Things"

Theological Heritage/Religious Identity

- Purpose: Salvation, Worship/Relationship, Sanctification/Daily Walk, Ministry
 - James 1:27, Galatians 6:2
 - Words and actions
 - Relationship with God
 - Relationship with Each Other
- Anabaptists, Protestants, Puritans, Separatists >> Congregational, Baptist, Presbyterian,
 Methodist, others = Evangelical Conservative Protestants>> Non-denom 'Bible' churches
- Non-Catholic, Non-Orthodox, Non-Episcopal
 - o Biblical Authority vs Institutional Church Authority (over Scripture & Salvation)
- Non-Charismatic (v Catholic, Pentecostal)
 - o Biblical Authority vs Individuals (closed cannon vs modern apostle)
- Biblical Authority vs Ecumenicalism (non-denom, but...) like faith and practice
 - 2 John 7-11, CF 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 (Lev 19:19, Deu 22:10 God's teaching point)
 - o Feminism, LGBT, Hinduism (accept all religion, symbol is Rainbow)
 - Hostility to separatists

Fundamental Commonality – Sola Fide, Sola Scriptura (and Natural Hermeneutic)

- Salvation by Faith, not works or by church actions/authority
- Scripture is the sole source of authority for Christian Faith and Practice

CI Scofield (1843-1921)

- Author of Scofield Study Bible
- Founded Philadelphia School of the Bible 1913

Lewis Sperry Chafer (1871-1952)

- Close associate of C.I Scofield (1843-1921) for over 20 years
- Assisted at Philadelphia
- Founder of Dallas Theological Seminary 1924
- Author of Systematic Theology (8 vol) and Major Bible Themes (Primary for Tyndale BI & TS)

John Walvoord (1910-2002)

- Succeeded Chafer as DTS President 1952-1986
- Taught at Tyndale

Charles Ryrie (1925-2016)

Author of Ryrie Study Bible

Attended and staff at DTS

Mal Couch (1938-2013)

- Founder Tyndale Theological Seminary
- John Brown University, Wheaton College, DTS, others
- Taught at Philadelphia, Moody, DTS
- Fundamentals for 21st Century Reaffirming 1917 Publication, 34 contributors

Arnold Fruchtenbaum (1943-)

- Studied at DTS
- Taught at Tyndale
- Founded Ariel Ministries

Norman Geisler (1932-2019)

- Prof at DTS
