Kings & Prophets

Jehoash (aka Joash)

- II Kings 11: 13-16 Jehoash takes the kingdom from Athaliah (Jehoiada is High Priest)
- 11:17-21 revival and inaguration
- 12:4-16 repair of the temple
- 12:17-18 buys his way out of war vs Hazael king of Aram
- II Chronicles 24:2, 15-19 Death of Jehoiada, turning away of Jehoash
- 24:20-22 Jehoash shows his depraved state
- 24:23-24, 25 God's judgment, the priests' judgment His son Amaziah suceeds, father of Uzziah

Note the half-hearted conversion from Athaliah's Baal-worship to Jehoiada's leadership back to Jehovah – both in the priests not rebuilding, and in the elders subverting the king after Jehoiada's death

Joel – Time is 835-ish BC, Prob near the end of Athaliah's reign, Jehoash is a child.

Four Parts:

- 2:12-27 Conditional promise of deliverance and blessing
- 2:28-3:21(end) End-Time Prophecies
