Kings & Prophets

(Uzziah >>) Jotham (G), Ahaz, Hezekiah (G), Manasseh, Amon, Josiah (G)

All generally contemporary to Isaiah, Micah, Jonah, and Nahum Hezekiah King during destruction of Israel, Josiah the last godly king of Judah

Manasseh – Evil king who repents

II Chronicles 33:1-6, trad. had Isaiah executed

II Chronicles 33:11-13, 15-16

Amon – Evil king

II Chronicles 33:21-25

Josiah – Last godly king of Judah – time of Zephaniah and Jeremiah

II Chronicles 34:1-7 - Purges the land of idolatry (8th year of reign = 15-16yo)

34:8a, c, 10-12a, $14 - Restoration of the temple (<math>18^{th}$ year = 25-26yo)

34:18-19, 21, 22-28 – Coming Judgment – Josiah, Huldah, (and Zephaniah & Jeremiah)

34:31-33 – Personal commitment, national repentance

35:1-19 (1-6, 17-18 – Passover, most significant since time of Samuel (still 18th year)

35:20-27 - (20, 23-24) (ruled 31 years, so age 39) dies in battle

Zephaniah - Promise of judgments, tiny call to repentance, restoration of the remnant

1:1 – throughout is judgment, except

2:1-3, 6-7 tiny call to repent

3:12-20 (end) restoration of the remnant
