Ezra

(Book of Ezra)

- 1. Ezra 7:6-10 The heart and commitment of Ezra (read)
 - a. Ezra 1-6 Zerubbabel restores the Temple, Passover celebrated (discuss)
- 2. Ezra 7:11++ The provision of the king (discuss)
- 3. Ezra 8:1-20 Gathers 1500, no Levites, goes and gets 258 Levites & priests (discuss)
- 4. Ezra 9 (Read 1-5, 10:1) Mixed marriages, repentance

Ezra's accomplishments (CF 7:6-10)

- Instrumental in restoration of temple worship (King's favor, treasure & people)
- Instrumental in excising foreign wives (source of idolatry)
- Wrote Ezra, Nehemiah (ed), I & II Chronicles
- (trad.) Translated at least the Pentateuch into Aramaic
- (trad.) Large contribution to Old Testament Canon
- (trad.) Instituted the Great Assembly, which became the Sanhedrin
- (trad.) Instituted weekly synagogue worship as seen time of Christ, forward
