This table contains all the TR Text verses/passages which the Critical Texts omit and over 60 other verses/passages with significant variances. I have strong confidence via multi-sourced information that the bulk of the manuscript-based New Testament variances are represented in these 81 passages. This table only considers variances between representatives of the TR, MT, and CT texts. The KJV is also provided for reference.
