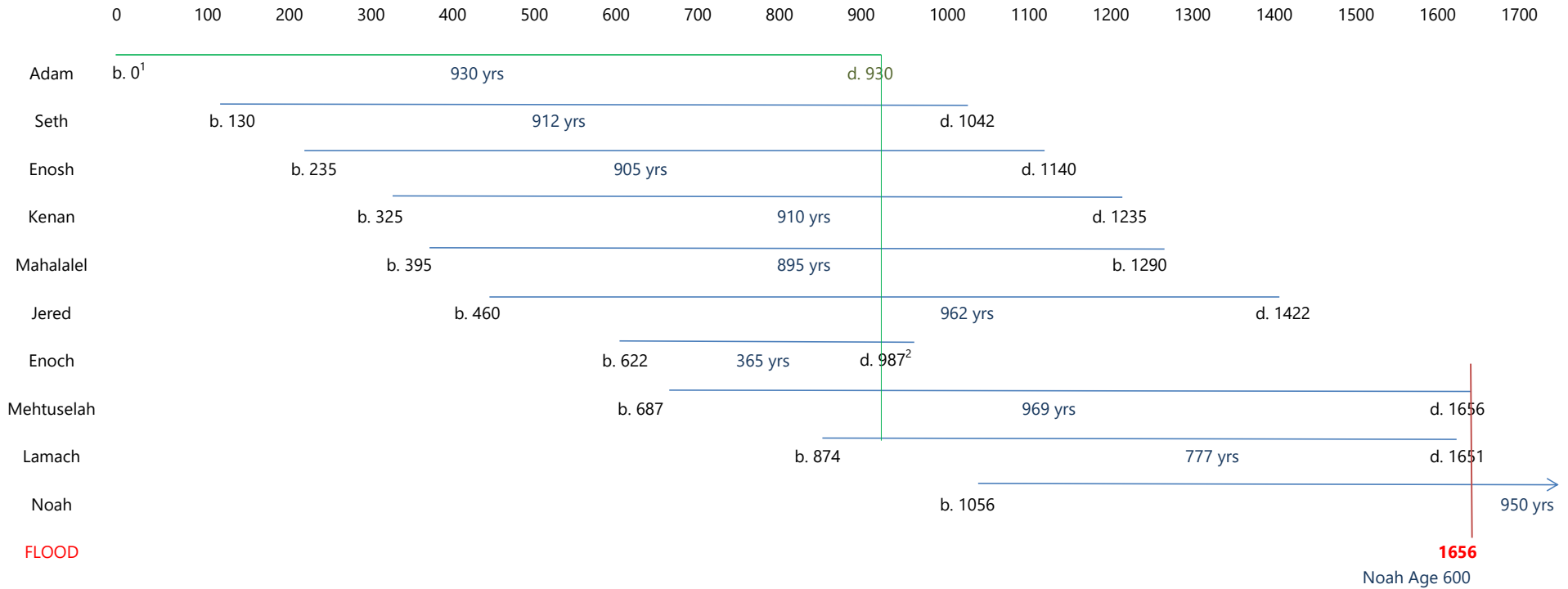


Antediluvian Lifespans - All but Noah contemporary with Adam

Years since creation, based on Adam's creation as Year 0



Notes: 1. Adam was created, not born (b.). 2) Enoch walked with God and God took him, not died (d.)

Table Explanation:

This table is reckoned from the life of Adam, and the years the Bible give for each persons birth and death.

For example:

1. Scripture tells us that Adam was 130 years old when he begat Seth, thus we use 130 (years since creation) for the birth of Seth.
2. Scripture tells us that Seth begat Enosh at the age of 105, so we use 105 + Adam's 130 = 235 for the birth year of Enosh.
3. Scripture tells us that Seth died at the age of died at the age of 930, so we use 930 + Adam's 130 = 1042 for the death of Seth.

Antediluvian Population:

If the average family began having children at age 100 and had 6 children in their lifetime, then the mathematical estimate of population would at the time of the flood would be 235 million. This is according to "Babel and the World Population : Biblical Demography and Linguistics" by Henry M. Morris, who considers this to be a conservative (low) estimate.
