Who wrote Job?

My guess – Moses recorded from father-in-law priest of Midian
Hidden Gems: The Faith of Job, early priestly activity

Job 1:1-4 Job had:

- 7,000 sheep >> 14,000
- 3,000 camels >> 6,000
- 500 oxen >> 1,000
- 500 donkeys >> 1000
- 7 sons, 3 daughters >> +7, +3
- his health >> +120 years

Hidden Gem 1 >> Job 1:5 Job administering family priestly office

Job 1:6-12 Satan allowed to test Job – Job loses all but health

Job 1:20,22 Job remains righteous

Job 2:7-8 Satan allowed to test Job – Job loses his health

Job 2:9-10 Job remains righteous

Three times friends say “Job is being judged for sin”, Job refutes each.

Hidden Gem 2 >> Job 19:23-27b – “My Redeemer liveth!”

Answer from God: I am Sovereign!, Job repents 42:1-6, God restores

Hidden Gem 3: Job becomes a priest for others outside his family 42:7-9
